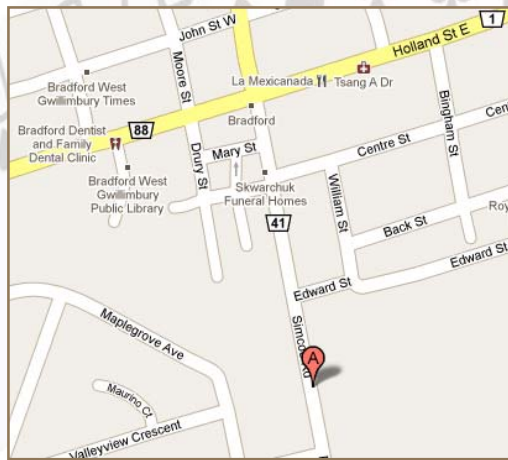

Yellow Brick House has helped abused women and children rebuild their lives for over 30 years.

Last year alone, 4000 women and children received assistance through our shelter and outreach services. 450 women and children came through our shelter. Unfortunately, over 547 women and children were turned away due to lack of space. Most of these women and children remained in their abusive homes.
