

# Greetings from the Executive Director & the Board President

Welcome to the 17th annual Yellow Brick House Gala! Thank you for joining us virtually to help break the silence surrounding domestic violence.

With your continued support Yellow Brick House provides life-saving services and prevention programs that empower women and children to begin healing from trauma and rebuilding their lives.

Last year we provided services to over 4,000 women and children, but our work is not done. In Canada, a woman is killed every 2.5 days as a result of gender-based violence, and since the start of the pandemic, there has been an increase of 30% in domestic violence. Isolating at home to keep safe and healthy is not possible if you are isolating with your abuser.

Our Fund a Need focus will be on securing funding for shelter beds, because when a woman calls us, ready to leave her abuser, we must be prepared to support her with a warm bed, safety, and shelter.

Because of your support, at Yellow Brick House, women and children have a safe place to begin healing from their trauma and to start rebuilding their lives free from violence.

### Facts about domestic violence

The lives of women and children in our community are in danger. In Canada:

+ A woman is killed every 2.5 days due to gender-based violence.

+ Children have become the primary 911 callers in domestic situations.

+ 1 in 6 women who come into fracture clinics have broken bones due to domestic violence.

+ 82% of callers to the crisis support line have children.

+ Exposure to domestic violence negatively impacts the development of children's brains. 60% suffer from PTSD.
