- 2. Interact and liaise with business owners and their staff
- 3. Create an open, dynamic, and engaging atmosphere and learning experience
- 4. Maintain accurate workshop data, including attendance records, evaluations, and other reporting documents
- 5. Administer feedback at visit to support the data collection requirements of funding agencies
- 6. Work in collaboration with Yellow Brick House staff to seek out, develop, and maintain relationships and opportunities with organizational partners (if requested/required)
- 7. Attend all training sessions and meetings as requested
- 8. Travel within York Region will be required
