Services are provided within a confidential environment that facilitates empowerment to help women and their children to rebuild their lives.

Summary of Position:

Under the supervision of the Resource Development staff, the Community Engagement volunteer will be responsible for supporting community engagement efforts at various community events. Such responsibilities include speaking with the public at events about domestic violence, the Yellow Brick House, volunteering opportunities, and available services, as well as collecting donations. The Community Engagement volunteer must demonstrate a commitment to serving Yellow Brick House clients and to upholding the Yellow Brick House mission. This position is ideal for an individual with strong adaptability, interpersonal skills, and verbal communication skills.









Responsibilities:

- Assist in planning and executing community events, workshops, and campaigns.
- Engage with community members through in-person, online, and telephone communications.
- Represent the organization at community events, networking opportunities, and meetings.
- Support the development of marketing materials and resources for outreach activities.
- Maintain accurate records of community interactions and feedback for reporting purposes.
- Collaborate with the Community Engagement Coordinator to identify new partnership opportunities.
- Monitor and respond to community inquiries, comments, and feedback on social media and other platforms.
- Conduct research on community needs and trends to inform outreach strategies.
- Travel within York Region to various venues required.

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Enthusiasm for community engagement and a passion for the organization's mission.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Excellent organizational and time-management abilities.
- Willingness to attend occasional evening or weekend events (if applicable).
