Norma's Story

After five years in Canada with my two kids, the excitement of a new life turned into a nightmare. My husband, our sponsor, changed after losing his job during the pandemic. He became abusive, using violence and threats to control us. Desperate, I wanted my kids to experience a happy Holiday Season despite the turmoil.

One night, a violent altercation led a concerned neighbour to call the police. Fearing for my children, I thought I would lose them. Surprisingly, my husband was arrested, and a police officer recommended contacting Yellow Brick House, a shelter. Reluctantly, I made the call, expecting the worst.

To my surprise, Yellow Brick House became our lifeline. Warmly welcomed, we found a safe haven with new clothes, toys, and emotional support. The shelter made our holiday season magical, thanks to generous donors. Counsellors, including one who spoke my language, guided us through the trauma, instilling hope for a brighter future.

During our three months at the shelter, Yellow Brick House helped us heal and provided legal and immigration counselling. Grateful for the support, we now have a path to escape the darkness and build a better future, empowered by the kindness of those who believed in us.
